Aleksandar Oklobdžija

Painting as rhythm, contrast and transformation

Aleksandar Oklobdžija is a painter with a degree in painting and restoration. He has been actively working in fine art and other artistic disciplines since 1994. He works primarily in oils, building each painting through thin, transparent layers, as well as in acrylics, while linear drawing provides the foundation for every new space.

His practice is rooted in European abstract expressionism and post-Cubist figuration, yet continually reaches towards the metaphysical. Forms float freely between pure abstraction, recognisable figures, landscape and architecture, while colour and an inner rhythm remain the main structure of the work.
